# A Simple Guide to Recycling Caps & Lids

Did you know Caps and Lids haven't been allowed in recycling bins since 2024, BUT you can still recycle them. Find Caps & Lids Recycling Scheme collection boxes at a supermarket near you, and give these materials a second life. Scan the QR code to find your nearest collection point and follow the simple steps below to save your caps and lids from landfill.

## PLASTIC YES ✓

### CAPS

- Flip top
- Hinged
- Screw
- Milk/drink bottle

### LIDS

- Ice cream container
- Supplement bottle
- Household cleaner
- Shampoo
- Cosmetic
- Yoghurt & dip (please do not include the peel-off film)

These go in the **PLASTIC BIN**

## METAL YES ✓

### CAPS

- Crown (bottle)
- Ring pull
- Screw

### LIDS

- Jar
- Aluminium
- Wine
- Food tin

### OTHER

- Wire from sparkling drinks

These go in the **METAL BIN**

## NO X

- Dirty or food covered items
- Coffee cup lids
- Coffee pods
- Glass
- Pumps
- Sprays
- Triggers
- Rubber
- Silicone
- Cork
- Mixed materials (don't mix plastic & metal together)

## Caps & Lids must be clean & dry

**What happens next?** Your caps and lids are collected through the Caps & Lids Recycling Scheme, operated by The Packaging Forum, and turned into new materials and products.
